

Code of Conduct – Adult

Membership

- All membership fees - both for SLSGB and Mullion SLSC - must be paid to Mullion SLSC. Membership of the club is only completed when fees have been paid, you have received the SLSGB Membership Card, **and** the MSLSC Membership Secretary has confirmed. If membership is not completed payments to MSLSC will be refunded.
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- Members of MSLSC may not also be members of another club
 - If you are already a member of another surf lifesaving club you may not join MSLSC
 - If you join another club whilst being a member of MSLSC your membership of MSLSC will be considered terminated immediately – with no refunds of membership fees due.
 - Please be aware that SLSGB members can only compete for one club and are tied to the first club they compete for each year (their 'first choice club').

Code of Practice

Mullion Surf Life Saving Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members, ensuring a positive and enjoyable experience for all. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with Chairman Simon Mitchell.

- All members must take responsibility for ensuring they are up to date with the rules, understand and adhere to them.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Members should recognize the valuable contribution made by coaches and officials who are volunteers. They give their time and resources to provide surf life saving activities and qualifications for you.
- All members must respect officials and publicly accept their decisions.

- All members should be a positive role model, treat other players and officials with the same level of respect you would expect to be shown to you.

- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Members are not allowed to smoke, consume alcohol or drugs on club premises or whilst representing the club
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.

- Members must wear suitable kit for training sessions and competitions as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Bullying of any sort will not be tolerated.
- Encourage everyone to enjoy sport and understand that people have different motivations for taking part.
