

Code of Conduct - Volunteer Membership

This membership category reflects that we rely on volunteers to run our activities safely with the relevant qualifications and encourage you to get involved. Please note the items below

1. To maintain volunteer membership you must assist on a minimum of 5 of the club's activities - which can be pool sessions, sessions in the sea or assisting at competitions.
2. If you are unable to meet this minimum requirement during a membership year then the full Membership fee applicable to your age will be due at the next renewal. Any exception to this will need to be approved at a meeting of the Trustees.
3. Relevant courses will be run by the club for Water Cover and Coaching. Through our affiliation with SLSGB these are sports accredited qualifications. Tube Rescuer (or Board Rescuer) and Level 1 coach are ideal for coaching and water cover and the club will cover the cost of these courses. Should you wish to you can go onto the Lifesaver/Lifeguard Courses which you will need to pay initially but which will be reimbursed after 10 hours of volunteering.
